Likewise, the objects used at Mass are sacred and holy. At Mass, we lift ourselves up to God and offer ourselves to him. We also make offerings to our parish to help support the Church.

One special way we show our love for God and give him thanks at Mass is during the Offertory collection. The Offertory collection is when we offer some of our money. The money from the collection goes to help the Church and to help the poor. One way we show God our love is by sharing the money he has given us with others who need it.

- Discuss the importance and obligation of putting money in the collection basket at Mass.
- Before Sunday Mass, as a family gather spare change or coins you find, and on Sunday, let one of the children put the donation in the collection basket.


Family Faith Activities
