#### Chapter Summary

We go to Mass to worship and adore God. At Mass, we worship God with words and our bodies. Blessing ourselves with holy water, genuflecting or bowing before the tabernacle, kneeling, standing, and folding our hands to pray are all forms of showing respect and reverence to God. At Mass, Jesus is present in his Word and in the Holy Eucharist. During the Mass, we both remember and participate in all that God has done for us, especially his Death and Resurrection. God's story of love continues with each one of us as we love God and one another and live our lives in faith with hope for eternal life.

#### **More for Parents**

Our bodies are necessary for us to communicate what we think and feel to those around us. Children understand this intuitively when they seek our reassurance and approval in terms of hugs, holding hands, and physical contact. Children insist, "Mom, Dad, look!" because they understand our body language says something about our attention and focus. Even though God knows what is in our hearts and minds, our bodies are still essential in order to show our love for him fully. At Mass, our bodies demonstrate to God and those around us our interior thoughts and dispositions toward God. Our attentiveness, our standing, sitting, kneeling, and even wearing our best clothes are all part of showing our attentiveness to God. How can you be deliberate about your body language communicating to your family and to God your focus, love, and attention?

- After Mass, remain in the pew and say a short prayer of thanksgiving as a family.
- Before Sunday Mass, read the Gospel to your children from a children's Bible so that they are familiar with the story.
